Create Learning Trust Work



During the past 3 weeks, staff from all 3 trust schools have come together for joint training in Basic Awareness for Safeguarding Children in Education and Elklan training which enables the speech and language development for our early years children.

Parking

A regular reminder that we politely request anyone dropping off or picking up children to park considerately and safely in the village. It is actually illegal to park, however briefly, on the zigzags outside of school.

It is also illegal to park within 10m of a junction. This is to allow drivers who are emerging from, or turning into, the junction a clear view of the road they are joining. It also allows them to see hazards such as pedestrians or cyclists at the junction. I have seen several families struggle to cross the road safely due to cars being parked on the turning into Orchard Drive.
